Game Contents

42 game cards:
1 Poo card
1 Toilet card
4 Plunger cards
36 food item cards (9 types, 4 each)
1 Rules booklet



Getting Started:

Shuffle the deck and deal out all cards.
Some players may have an extra card
compared to other players.

That's okay!



All players look at their cards.
If anyone has any two matching
food card types, they discard them
into a discard pile. **All** matching pairs
must be discarded.

If any player has three of the
same cards, they discard two
cards (one pair). If they have four
of the same cards they can discard all
four cards (two pair).



All cards that players are not able to
discard should be kept hidden!



Game Objective

Don't get stuck holding the Poo!

Flush it! Use the plunger! Trick another
player into taking it off your hands...
but keep it far away!

Laugh at the player stuck holding the
Poo when the game ends!

After all players have discarded all of their matching pairs, the youngest player begins by drawing a single random card from the player on their left or right.

If a card that was drawn matches a food card in hand, the pair must be discarded immediately.

Then, play continues around the table in the initial direction, allowing each player to draw **one card** and discard pairs if able.

A player, on their turn...

May play one or more Plunger cards

Must draw a card from a player according to the current direction

Must discard any Food card pairs


May Flush the Poo (a good idea)! 

The Plunger Card:

The Plunger card can be played at the beginning a player's turn **or** at the very end of their turn.



When a Plunger card is played, it is discarded immediately and removed from the game.

The Plunger card **switches the direction** players are drawing cards from their neighbor. 

If the players had been drawing cards from their right, they would now switch to drawing cards from the player on their left.

It is possible to play more than one Plunger card on a turn.



The Toilet Card:

Whenever a player has the Toilet card and the Poo card in their hand they can **flush** the Poo card by giving it to **any player** of their choice.

The Poo Card:

If a player is holding the Poo card with no food cards in their hand and they don't have the Toilet card, **they lose the game.** A Plunger won't help now!



OH POO!

 When flushing the Poo, the player has to **reveal the Toilet card.**

The player keeps the Toilet card after flushing the poo.

The Toilet card never gets discarded, but can switch from player to player if randomly drawn.

Anytime a player discards all of their food cards and have no other cards in hand, they have safely avoided the Poo and are "out." They can now sit back and watch the remaining players struggle to avoid being stuck with the Poo card!
